When you see the Audience Participation logo it means "TAKE PART"! If you throw yourself into it you'll have more fun and feel like you're part of the show.

So what do I do exactly?


When you see this image on the screen...

During the **Foree Electric** shop scene, mimic the shop assistants by chewing your gum.

Please dispose of your gum appropriately



Shout "Hello Maaate" into your phone when either Ed or Noel (Foree Electrical Assistant) get a mobile phone call.



When Chicago's "If You Leaf Me Now" plays, throw the leaves from your goody bag as Liz sings the first line.



When **Shaun** & **Ed** start throwing the records you start throwing yours! See if you can hit "Mary" or "Hulk" with it.

The ever important *vinyl* is there for you to throw. Don't worry, they won't hurt, we've tested them.

SCRIPT

<u>Lines</u> are an intrinsic part of the show, and you can join in. Our adaptation of the film to stage has all the famous lines and if you **know more**, say more! We encourage it!

When **Shaun** is in **Liz**'s flat, the lines are as follows:

David: "Basically I think your Nine lives are up!"

Shaun & AUDIENCE: "GET FUCKED FOUR-EYES!"

When **Shaun** is in the pub after **Liz** has dumped him, the juke box springs to life. The lines are:

Ed: "Who the hell put this on?"

Shaun & AUDIENCE: "It's on random!"

When **Shaun** has woken with a hangover from the party, he wakes **Ed**, the lines are:

Shaun: "Do you want anything from the shop?"

Ed & AUDIENCE: "CORNETTO!"

When **Shaun** is in **Liz**'s flat the second time to rescue her, the lines are as follows:

David: "But there were only two of them a minute ago and now *how many are there?*"

Dianne & AUDIENCE: "LOTS!"

So now you're getting in the mood, we can start to really get some of you into the action!

ZOMBIF Crowd. You will have been selected by one of our **ZOMBIFS**. And this means they may come and find you and bring you up out of your seat to start moving with the others. Try to make sure you get tickets for the stalls and seating close to the aisles to get a chance to do this.



During the music you are free to do your best air guitar. Feel free to bash a nearby Zombie with it if you get the chance.



A popular belief is that Alabama Vest, an African-American in Macon, Georgia was the one who invented the kazoo around 1840. You can join in on any songs if you don't want to sing, in particular the end.



As with bashing any Zombies over the head with your air guitar, if you see anyone participating in this fashion (yawning) feel free to bash them with your air guitar too.

The most important thing is to enjoy the night together. We all know that it's a sure fire winner dressing up and participating.
